## **Golden Rules**

#### **Range Shooting**

- 1. Remember the 7 Golden Rules of Firearms Safety
- 2. Know the Nelson Range Standing Orders 2019 (under ply cover in Hut)
- 3. Only put bolt in action when at shooting table
- 4. Never walk in front of firing line until all are agreed "cease shooting"
- 5. Never recommence shooting until all are agreed that everybody is back behind firing line
- 6. Remove bolt from firearm or use breech flag and step away from table when "cease shooting" is agreed
- 7. When in doubt don't shoot; check your firing zone and look left and right
- 8. Don't load your firearm until ready to fire
- 9. Use hearing protection and wear Hi-viz
- 10 Directly control children, spectators and dogs in your care at all times

#### Range Etiquette

- 1. Respect our range
- 2. All shooters must always sign the book (initials, membership number)
- 3. For non-competition events park in parking area not behind benches
- 4. Toilet at rear of range building (always unlocked)
- 5. Regularly check to see when others are ready to "cease shooting" and check their targets
- 6. Make sure other shooters have their earmuffs on when shooting starts
- 7. Take your rubbish, used targets and cases home
- 8. Don't walk on bullet stop banks
- 9. Offer to help if someone seems to be having problems
- 10. Drive carefully on access road with lights on

# The 7 golden rules of Firearms Safety

- 1. Treat every firearm as loaded
- 2. Always point firearms in a safe direction
- 3. Load a firearm only when ready to fire
- 4. Positively identify your target beyond all doubt
- **5.** Check your firing zone
- **6.** Store firearms and ammunition safely
- 7. Avoid alcohol or drugs when handling firearms
